A-ADMIT:

- **Admitting Doctor:** Dr. Dony Levis
- **Referring Physician:** Dr. Jorge Straight
- **Special needs:** None

D-DIAGNOSIS:

- **Primary diagnosis:** Foot infection, osteomyelitis big toe
- **Secondary diagnosis:** DMII
- **Functional status:** Alert

D-DISCHARGE PLANNING:

- **Define Goals:** Amputation of big toe and discharge 2 days after
- **Discharge Criteria:** Wound cultures for antibiotics
- **Family & social worker:** able to go home

C-CONDITION & CODE STATUS:

- **Condition:** Fair
- **Code status:** Full Code
 - Patient able to make full decisions

V-VITAL SIGNS:

- **Frequency:** Q4H check all vitals

A-ALLERGIES

- Penicillin - patient unable to breath, neck swells up (ALLERGY ALERT)

N-NURSING ORDERS:

- Palliative care: wash patient x1 daily
- Pressure ulcer prevention: out of bed
- Topical cream applications: Legs for venous stasis dermatitis

D-DIET ORDERS

- **Diet:** 1800-calorie ADA, diabetic diet
- **NPO:** Nothing by Mouth Wednesday night for surgery the following day

A-ACTIVITY LEVEL

- avoid bed rest, always maximize activity
- orders for: up in chair
- ambulation orders for nursing and if necessary consult PT

L-LABS:

- CBC, BMP, PT/INR, PTT,
- ESR, CRP
- HgA1C, Blood Glucose, Lactic Acid

I-IV FLUIDS:

- maintenance 30cc/kg/24hr, increase for illness, emphasize oral route when possible.

S-SPECIAL ORDERS:

- XRAY 3 views of the foot, Right foot
- MRI of the Right foot
- DVT prophylaxis - SCDs bilateal

M-MEDICATIONS:

As noted in chart:

- ASA 81mg
- Metformin 500mg
- Gabapentin 600mg
